Often called the most scenic drive in Canada, the Parkway hosts breathtaking views of rivers, lakes, glaciers, mountains and wildlife.


VRC's overnighter up the Parkway is July 8 and 9.


The Kaslo Kurves Ride is scheduled for August 11 to 13.

## National Park Pass mystery unravelled

How many motorcycles can go into a National Park on one park pass?

That question has been tossed around in the riding forums online for quite a while, so our Road Captain Big Don came up with a novel solution - He asked Parks Canada.

In an email response, Parks Canada said up to seven, but there is a catch. Two catches, actually: 1.) It has to be a valid Family/Group Discovery Pass (\$145.95) and 2.) it is valid for seven PEOPLE, not seven motorcycles. Rider and passenger, obviously, are two people. This is apparently where much of the confusion has arisen in the past.

VRC is purchasing a Family/Group Discovery Pass and we will make sure that we have enough passes to cover any trips we make in the national parks.
