Parked it in an unheated garage with cardboard under the tires, connected a battery tender to it. Threw a cover over it, and bid it a tearful farewell."

Ed G. found he needed a new drive belt when we did his end-of-season inspection. He has 86,000 kms on the old belt. His **XCT** is getting new **wheel bearings and seals**, as well as new

His Victory is also getting a new **windshield** to replace the one damaged by living in the Arizona heat. "I am also looking for a different exhaust," Randy says.

Tracey plans to comfort **Ruby**, her Cross Country, over the winter. "She's sleeping in the garage. I give her hugs every day and say, 'soon, my precious' so she doesn't get lonely."

A couple of members were coy about what **performance enhancements** they were planning over the winter. We will have to wait until Spring to see what they have done to their rides, if we can catch them.


Merry Vicmas! planning starts Dec. 17
