Vicmas!...

The rules, read and obey

The highlight of Vicmas! is everyone's favourite blood sport - **The Vicmas Gift Exchange/Theft**. Rules are simple:

- Bring a **wrapped present** containing something motorcycle (preferably Victory) related. Something worth **about \$25** (new or used parts, gloves, helmet, two-year-old old Harley, a windshield, chrome bits; new used or salvaged from your garage. (Or your neighbours'; we don't judge.)

It can be anything that can be **enjoyed** while installing on, looking at, riding on, drinking beside or just sitting on a Victory **motorcycle**.

- Those participating will draw a **number** that indicates their parcel

picking order.

- The **lowest number picks** a parcel and then must open it for all to view.

- Next lowest number goes next and can steal the previous gift or open a new one.

- A parcel can only be **stolen three times** then it becomes the permanent possession of the new owner. If your parcel is stolen, you are now able to **steal** an available opened one **or take a new parcel** and unwrap it.

- This continues until all parcels are opened.
